Diseases such as polio, tuberculosis, diphtheria and whooping cough, largely preventable by vaccine, are still prevalent in Haiti. The children of Haiti will receive vaccinations from these diseases in the new clinic. The clinic will also provide first aid and basic health care. A number of physicians and nurses are waiting for the clinic to be completed so that they can visit on medical missions to provide care. Another major cause of illness in Haiti is malnutrition. The clinic will help treat malnutrition by providing meals through its food distribution program.

“Amer-Haitian Bon Zami”, translated into English, means “American/Haitian good friends”. House of Hope, a part of Amer-Haitian Bon Zami, was established as a girl’s orphanage in 1976 and currently provides housing, education, spiritual guidance, and health care for 26 girls. On March 10, 2008, a groundbreaking ceremony was held for the “Patti’s School”, which adjoins House of Hope/Patti’s School will educate over 200 children from the neighborhood. It will also provide vocational education for many adults in the evening. The House of Hope Family Clinic will be the third part of the complex. It will offer health care and food for the needy in the community.

Haiti is the poorest nation in the Western Hemisphere. Despite living in material poverty, the people of Haiti have an enormous amount of endurance, hope and dignity, as well as deep spiritual faith, but they need your help to fight against extreme poverty. The unemployment rate in Haiti is over 60%, with average annual income of \$250. The average life expectancy is 47 for men and 51 for women. Many children die before the age of 5 of diseases that can easily be treated. Please help us make a difference in Haiti.
